## **Aboriginal Teaching Assistant Role**

We are seeking an Aboriginal Teaching Assistant to join our staff. The role involves supporting students in the class and building connections with our indigenous families. This is a part time position 0.5 FTE. The work days and times are negotiable.

The role of the Aboriginal Teacher Assistant involves supporting Aboriginal students engagement in learning, building connections with our indigenous families. We are looking for someone who has a passion for increasing cultural awareness while supporting students and increasing staff knowledge and awareness.

St Paul's School Karratha is a double stream co-educational school with 400 students from Kindergarten – Year 6. The school sits on Ngarluma land and draws on the knowledge and culture of the Ngarluma and Yindjibarndi people.

### Selection Criteria

- Support the teacher in the delivery of teaching and learning programs, including individual and small group sessions
- Provide Aboriginal cultural advice where it can assist
- Provide student pastoral care support
- Liaise with and support parents and carers
- Be supportive of the Catholic ethos of the school
- Sound written and oral communication skills
- Competency in the use of ICT
- A willingness to be actively involved in and supportive of school events and initiatives
